

The security provided doesn't include who you interact with while at the mountain. It's paramount that you are conscious of who you associate with while here.

Nations Prayer Mountain has pastors who provide daily prayer and counseling sessions under the Prayer department. (You can inquire at the reception)

Please note that Nations Prayer Mountain pastors do not walk around asking you if you need prayer. Anyone who approaches you or solicits money for prayers isn't part of us, report such cases to the administration office, and you should be conscious when dealing with them to avoid cases of fraud.
